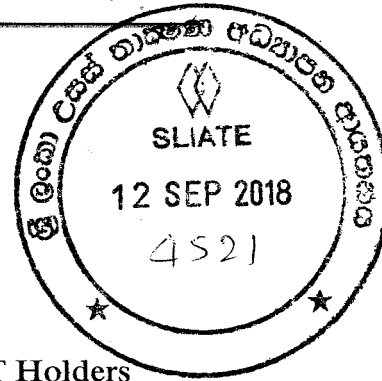
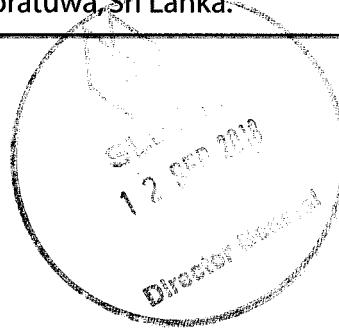

Lateral Entry in to BIT (External) Degree Programme for HNDIT Holders (SLIATE)

I am pleased to inform you that the Senate of University of Moratuwa has approved the following exemptions to candidates who have completed all the course modules in the HNDIT curriculum including the final project from Level 1 and Level 2 course modules of the BIT External Degree Programme as listed in Table 1 and Table 2, respectively. General and specific conditions for such exemptions are also listed below under sections 1 and 2.

1. General Recommendations


The general recommendations and the methodology to follow when considering/allowing lateral entry for an applicant would be as follows.

1. Exemptions, if any, are to be given on a course module basis of the BIT External Degree Programme.
2. Titles of course modules, their content, assessments and the number of credits are to be taken in to account when deciding on exemptions.
3. The Maximum grade awarded for an exempted course module of BIT External Degree Programme will be “C” for the purpose of calculating the GPA or similar requirements.
4. The transcript of a candidate who has got exemptions for BIT course modules should indicate the word “Exempted “for each such exempted course module.

2. Specific Recommendations

Subject to the above general recommendations, the following recommendations are made with regard to the HNDIT:

1. Candidates who have completed all the modules in HNDIT curriculum including the final project and at least have started internship will be eligible to apply for exemptions.
2. Candidates admitted as in (1) above should complete the HNDIT internship (06 months) before registering for any modules of Level 3 of the BIT External Degree.
3. Candidates coming through the lateral entry system getting exemptions for BIT Level 1 and Level 2 course modules will be awarded the BIT External Degree only, upon completions of the requirements but not any other intermediate qualifications such as Diploma in IT and Higher Diploma in IT.
4. Awarding of classes for the BIT External Degree will be determined according to the performance criteria, which specifies that only the performance (GPA) in the Level 3 is considered for awarding classes.
